An important goal was to present the project in general and to offer the possibility for all partners and interested citizens and organisations to get to know each other.

25 persons participated in situ and 6 additional participants joined online.

We presented and described the roles of the involved persons within the project as well as the main milestones and timelines. The timeline and next deliverables were adjusted and the updated dates were announced.

The content of the workshop was to exchange ideas, knowledge and methods about women in the resistance against National Socialism in Germany and France. Different definitions and approaches about the resistance in Germany and France were discussed. Differences in the approach of schools and museums in teaching the topic were also discussed.

A first presentation on methods of working in exhibitions took place, which will be deepened in another workshop later.

Due to the intensive cooperation with school children, the child protection policy and its adoption by all partners involved in the project played a central role. Even though all partners and participants have extensive experience in working with children, it was important that all of them got to know and adopted the contents of the child protection policy.

In the discussion that followed, numerous ideas were put forward by the partners and interested citizens on the topics of female resistance as well as on possible mediation formats and events.
